The Flathead National Forest is requesting public input on the issuance of a temporary permit authorizing **Whitefish Shuttle Livery and Guiding** on the Tally Lake Ranger District. Activities would take place in a MA 7 Focused Recreation area. The project would be authorized using 36 CFR 220.6(d)(8): *Approval, modification, or continuation of minor, short-term (1 year or less) special uses of National Forest System lands.*

Whitefish Shuttle is requesting a permit to provide shuttle services to the Round Meadow Cross Country Ski Area trailhead and guiding for cross country skiers and snowshoers. (See Map 1) The permit would allow activities to occur between Dec 23, 2019 and April 1, 2020.

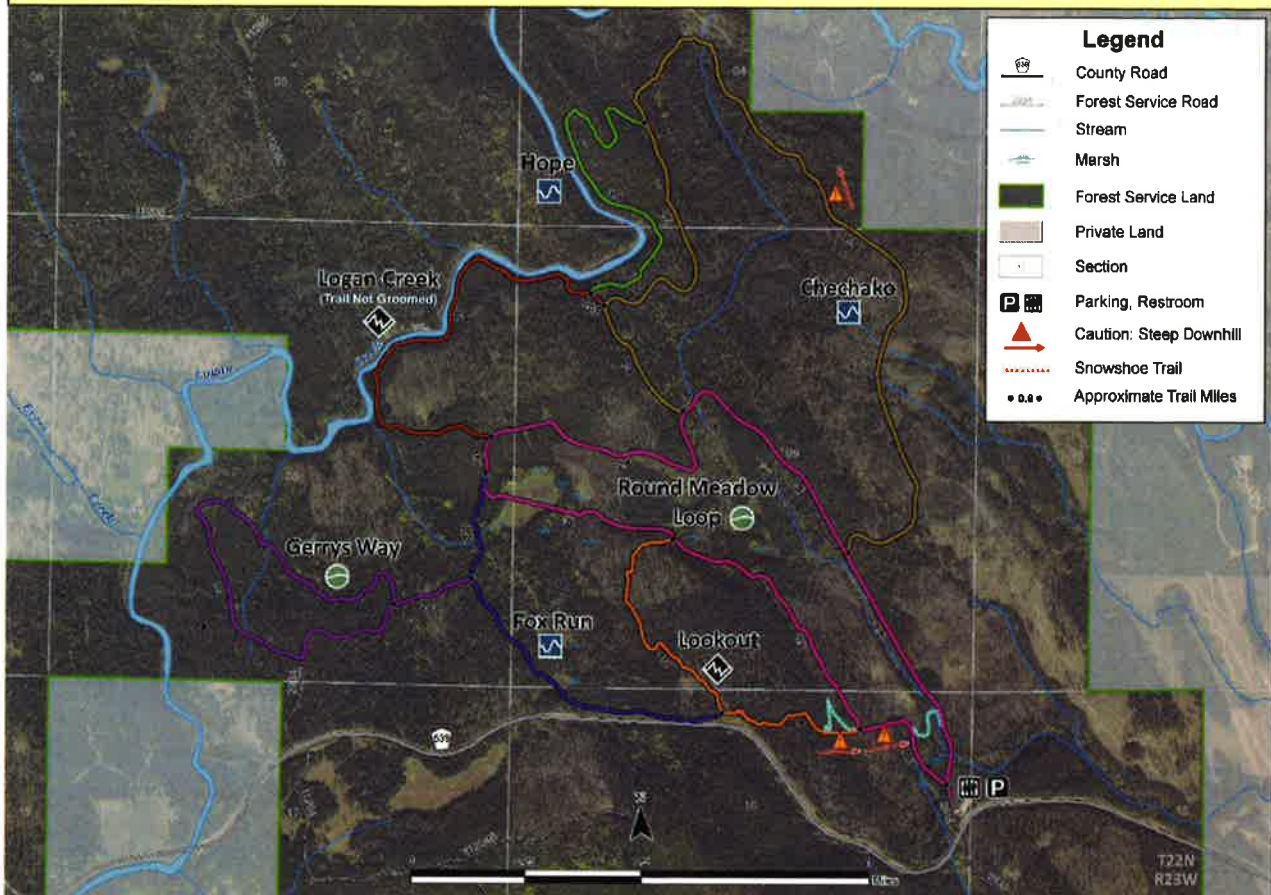
